The Ronald McDonald House Charities Global Office recently recognized the Ronald McDonald House of Cleveland's **Tools for Today and Tomorrow** program with a "Best Bets" Award. Programs from all 270 Houses were eligible to receive this world-wide recognition. The Best Bets award comes with a \$5,000 grant and can earn an additional \$10,000 at the Ronald McDonald House Charities Global Conference in August should the program be an overall category winner.



The Tools for Today and Tomorrow program is the result of an unprecedented collaboration of leaders from hospitals, universities and organizations in the Greater Cleveland area that understand the non-medical challenges that families of children with special needs face. The program is designed to link families to information, resources and support about medical and educational advocacy, family, financial and legal issues through workshops, a website and biennial conferences.
